

Camp Fees

The camp fees this summer can be paid in two parts.

➔ \$100 - March 30th

➔ \$250 - May 19th



Troops will submit payment to the council on the scout's behalf but Scouts, not the units, should cover all camp costs. This prevents the unit from losing money if a Scout cannot attend camp and has not yet paid.

➔ Late Fees

Any camper fees not paid in full by May 19, will be charged a \$20 late fee.

- Camper Rate-\$350
- Adult Fees-\$100
- Partial Week-\$50

➔ Program Fees

On Tuesdays, a Council representative will be at camp to meet with each unit to settle all troop invoices and make reservations for the following year. Leader fees and program fees can be paid at this time.



LEADERS IN CAMP

All units are required to always have at least two adult leaders in camp. This policy is required by the Boy Scouts of America. All leaders must be registered members of the Boy Scouts of America, must meet qualifications for the leadership position in which they serve, and have completed Youth Protection Training. The two-unit leaders must be at least 21 years of age.

Any additional leaders must be at least 18 years of age. Parents, committee members, and other adults who accompany the units to camp must meet all the above requirements.

➔ Rotating Leaders

Leaders may rotate when necessary, however, for the best interest of the Scouts, we recommend having consistent leadership throughout your unit's stay at camp. Rotation of leaders can give way to situations that ARE NOT conducive to the positive influences of a week of summer camp.

➔ Free Leader Ratio

- 1-5 Scouts = 1-Free Leader
- 6-19 Scouts = 2-Free Leaders
- 20-29 Scouts = 3-Free Leaders
- 30+ Scouts = 4-Free Leaders

REFUND POLICY

Planning and purchasing for camp occur long before camp begins. Consequently, refunds are made as follows:

- Cancellations on or before May 19. All fees are transferable within the reservation. If the entire unit reservation cancels, the site deposit will be forfeited.
- Cancellations after May 19. A refund of all fees paid less \$100 per scout. A written request must be submitted to the Council Office.
- Cancellations after June 3: NO refunds will be issued unless the Scout in question is in one of these circumstances:
 - There is a death in the family
 - There is a serious illness in the immediate family
 - The Scout is ill and unable to attend camp

If a refund is granted, it will be for fees paid less than \$100 deposit. These refunds will be measured by the refund policy above and granted accordingly. Refunds will be mailed to the currently registered Scoutmaster and will be combined with any other refunds due, less any outstanding debts the unit owes to the council.
