



# Mario Cart Scout Powered Race!

Build and race your Mario cart against other troops on Friday Afternoon.

**Rule 1: Each troop may submit ONE car in the race.** Regardless of the size of an individual troop, no troop will be allowed to enter more than ONE car.

**Rule 2: The car must be powered by scout power up to two scouts to push or pull and one rider. The helmet must be worn by the rider.** The team will start with pushers or pullers and one rider. They will navigate the course on the ground to a designated location and then take it to the water with two people. They must paddle the car to the finish line. All scouts riding and powering the car must wear at least a helmet. **Helmets are not provided by the camp.**

**Rule 3: Scouts are encouraged to construct the entire car with little help from unit leaders.** The staff at CBS hopes this event will bring your troop together in making a car of which the entire troop can be proud. Leaders are encouraged to give guidance and provide resources, when necessary, otherwise let the scouts do the building.

**Rule 4: NO motorized parts will be allowed on the car.** Please do not try to use motors of any kind to propel your car.

**Rule 5: The use of any pre-made, store-bought parts is prohibited other than wheels and axles.** Troops may use pre-made or store-bought wheels and axles.

**Rule 6: Each unit must identify its car with at least its troop number.** This will allow the staff to identify each car and each unit participating. Cars not identified may be disqualified.

**Rule 7: Each unit is expected to remove all parts of their car and discard them properly.** Remember, Scouts, leave things better than they found them. Any unit that does not completely remove and properly dispose of their car will be disqualified from any and all recognitions/awards and points.

**Rule 8: No cars are to be disposed of in the dumpster.** Troops improperly disposing of their car will be subject to a \$20 fee and immediate disqualification.

**Rule 9: The CBS staff will judge the competition.** All rulings by the staff are final. If your unit is disqualified for any reason, you may be allowed to participate. You will not, however, be competing for recognition/awards or points.
